The Nineteenth Sunday of Ordinary Time Saint Luke Church, Whitestone, New York

Dear Friends,

Last week the news reported about Fr. Frank Hughes, now the former pastor of St. Pancras Parish in Glendale, NY, who was arrested by the FBI on charges of sharing sexually explicit photos and texts with a minor. This week's *Tablet* will also cover the story. As a priest, it is hard enough to hear the stories of clergy sexual abuse that go back many years; it is infuriating to hear that it is still going on. As your new pastor, I feel that I cannot ignore the report and pretend that it never happened. While I am not a parent, I come from a very close family and am blessed with nieces and nephews, as well as the children and grandchildren of my many cousins. The protection of children and young people is an essential part of my ministry as a priest and pastor. I am fully committed to work with the staff and parishioners to assure that St. Luke Parish provides a safe environment for all people, particularly the youngest among us.

We have contacted parishioners who lost loved ones during the period when funeral Masses were not permitted to be celebrated, and we have started to set dates for Memorial Masses here at St. Luke. Please know that Fr. Kim, Fr. Colalella and I will do all we can to offer families the consolation of the faith, especially in these difficult times. We were only able to contact families who brought their loved ones to the church for a blessing before going to the cemetery. If you'd like to arrange for a Memorial Mass for family members and friends who died since mid-March, please don't hesitate to contact the rectory so we can help you plan a proper memorial. Know of the continued prayers of our parish family for the souls of the faithful departed, and for the consolation of those who grieve and mourn. Please remember, too, that Sr. Theresa Agliardi offers bereavement ministry and outreach to our community. If you are burdened by grief, please reach out for assistance.

On August 15 every year, the Church celebrates the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This year, because the solemnity falls on a Saturday, there is no obligation to attend Mass. Also, the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy days is still lifted in the Diocese of Brooklyn while we continue to exercise caution because of COVID-19. We will celebrate a Vigil Mass at St. Luke on Friday, August 14 at 7:30 PM, and the regular Saturday 8:30 AM Mass to honor the Assumption of Mary. We will also celebrate First Communion Masses on that day. Please pray for the intercession of Mary to help all of us to remain safe and to find our hope in the Lord. If you are not able to come to church for Mass, please pray the Rosary to honor Our Lady on her feast!
