# The Twentieth Sunday of Ordinary Time Saint Luke Church, Whitestone, New York

# Dear Friends,


We've been back to regular Mass celebrations for over six weeks now, and I thank God that so far all has gone well here at St. Luke. Fr. Paul gathered a great team of volunteers who have been diligent in sanitizing the church in between Masses on the weekend. We have been able to accommodate everyone who has come to church for Mass, and the numbers have slowly been going up as people feel more comfortable venturing out while holding to the protocols of wearing masks and keeping the proper distance from others. I just want to remind parishioners that we need to be diligent in wearing masks while in church that cover our noses and mouths for the safety of everyone. We continue to live stream Mass at 9:00 AM and 11:45 AM on Sundays for the sake of those who are not ready or able to return to church for Mass. This weekend we celebrated the first two of six First Communion celebrations for our parish children; we pray in a special way for all the children who will receive the Eucharist for the first time during the month of August here at St. Luke. Congratulations to them and their families!

The governor recently announced the opening of schools in New York State this fall, and Mrs. Brunswick and the faculty and staff have been working above and beyond the call of duty to make sure everything is in place at St. Luke School for this September. We will follow all the guidelines of the city, state and diocese to do everything possible to keep everyone safe when school resumes in a few weeks. Sr. Katherine is also planning a new year of faith formation for the children enrolled in our religious education program. We are grateful to the catechists and other parishioners who volunteer their time and talent to share their faith and to provide a secure environment for the children.

On Friday of this week the Church celebrates the memory of Pope St. Pius X who died on August 20, 1914. He is probably best remembered for encouraging the frequent reception of Holy Communion, especially for children. A theme of his pontificate was to "re-establish all things in Christ." He brought about liturgical reforms with a particular emphasis on the beauty of chant, and he strongly supported the orthodox teachings of the Church in response to the threats of Modernism in the early 20<sup>th</sup> century. He was canonized a saint in 1954. *St. Pius X, pray for us!*

# St. Luke is now open for Mass!

- The regular Mass has resumed as of June 29th.
- Those who are ill or showing signs of illness should NOT come to church.
- Congregation is limited to 25% capacity.
- Masks must be worn.
- Social distancing of 6 feet must be maintained for individuals.
- Pews will be clearly marked to show where people may or may not sit.

- There will be no hymnals used during liturgies.
- There will be no holy water in the fonts.
- There will be no servers, only 1 lector, and Extraordinary Ministers will be assigned as needed.
- There will be no procession at the beginning or end of Mass.
- There will be no holding hands during the Lord's Prayer and no exchange of peace.
- Those receiving Holy Communion are urged to receive in the hand.

St. Rocco

Feast Day: August 16

St. Rocco lived in the middle of the 14th century. He was born in France, and he had a birthmark in the shape of a cross on his chest. He was orphaned at the age of 20 and made a pilgrimage to Rome. At that time, Italy was being ravaged by the plague. Rocco was able to heal many of those stricken with the disease by praying for them and making the sign of the cross over them. Eventually, he, too, was struck with the disease and had an open sore on his leg. The people banished him from the city and he found refuge in a cave. A dog would bring him food to nourish him. The dog's owner, a nobleman, eventually followed the dog and discovered Rocco in the cave. He brought him to his castle where Rocco was cured.

He eventually returned to France, but he was so weak and sick that the people didn't recognize him, so they accused him of being a spy and put him in jail where he remained for five years. On August 16, 1378, he was clearly dying, and a blue light that radiated from his body illumined his cell. When the governor heard of this, he insisted on seeing it for himself. He did not recognize Rocco as his nephew because of his illness, but Rocco showed him the birthmark on his chest and the governor immediately realized that Rocco was indeed his nephew.

St. Rocco is venerated in the Catholic Church as a protector against the plague and other contagious diseases. He is recommended as an intercessor for the world today as many people suffer from the effects of coronavirus. St. Rocco, pray for us!
