The Twenty First Sunday of Ordinary Time Saint Luke Church, Whitestone, New York

Dear Friends,

Earlier this year I heard about a survey of Americans asking them how old is "old." To my surprise, the response was 57. I just turned 57 this week, so I guess your new pastor is officially "old." At the same time, to add insult to injury, I woke up on Monday morning with a case of shingles. I have a rash around my right eye and have spent the first part of the week going to doctors and pharmacies. While doing his exam, my ophthalmologist found cataracts, so I'll be dealing with those issues when my shingles are under control. In the meantime, I will be careful to keep myself away from others while my shingles are contagious. Thanks for your patience and your prayers.

It seems like with each passing week a few more people are finding their way back to church. The daily Mass at noon has had a pretty decent attendance almost from day one, and the weekend celebrations are slowly growing as well. It never hurts to remind everyone that it is important to follow the current protocols for the city: keep your masks covering your nose and mouth at all times except when receiving Communion. Some people are wearing their masks very loosely or with their nose or mouth exposed, and this can put others at risk, so I ask you to please wear the masks properly while in church for your own safety and for the safety of others. Also, remember to keep at least six feet away from others when entering or exiting the church, and when you come up for Communion. I appreciate your cooperation.

As the August days slip away, both Mrs. Brunswick and Sr. Katherine are working hard to coordinate the reopening of the school and religious education program in September. It has been very stressful to keep up with all the directives coming from the government and from the diocese, but be assured that they are doing their best to conform to all the guidelines that are being issued to keep the health and safety of students, faculty and staff as the highest priority here at St. Luke. At this point it is hard to determine what "parish life" will be like this fall. We will do all we can to bring things "back to normal" in the best way we can, but I ask everyone to please be patient as we all try to make plans during very uncertain times. While the city and state are doing very well right now in keeping COVID numbers very low, we are not sure what the fall will bring. We are truly grateful to all the volunteers who are sanitizing the church in between Masses on the weekend, and to everyone who is helping the parish in any way at this time. It is wonderful to see such a generous spirit in the community. We are truly blessed!

On Tuesday and Wednesday this week we have beautiful saint celebrations. On Tuesday we celebrate St. Monica. After the Blessed Mother, St. Monica can truly be counted among the great patron saints of mothers, since he prayers and tears led to the conversion of her son, St. Augustine, who is celebrated on Wednesday. He famously led a life of sin as a pagan to become not only a convert but a great bishop and doctor of the Church. I often recommend praying to St. Monica to mothers who are struggling with their children. St. Monica and St. Augustine, pray for us!
