The Twenty Second Sunday of Ordinary Time
Saint Luke Church, Whitestone, New York

Dear Friends,

A late Labor Day gives us another week of "vacation." I hope that our parishioners can make good use of these final days of summer for rest and family time. On September 1st we return to the regular weekday Mass schedule: on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays Mass will be celebrated at 7:00 AM and 12:00 Noon; on Tuesdays and Thursdays Mass will be celebrated at 8:30 AM and 12:00 Noon; on Saturdays Mass will remain at 8:30 AM only. Friday, September 4th, is First Friday, so we will have Eucharistic Adoration from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM. After all the turmoil of these past several months, I encourage all parishioners to make the effort to spend some quiet time with the Lord.

This weekend we will have finished all the First Communion celebrations for the children who just finished second grade in our school and religious education program. I reminded the parents that "First" Communion presumes that there will be a "second" and "third" (and so on) Communion. The Church teaches that parents are the primary teachers of their children in the faith. Local parishes assist parents by providing catechesis and formation to their children, but nothing can replace the lived example of parents who make the effort to bring their children to church regularly. I am encouraged when a child comes into the confessional on a Saturday afternoon followed by the parent who accompanied the child. How wonderful! It is great to see families coming to Mass together on the weekend. It seems that sports and other activities will be very limited this fall while we continue to deal with COVID. Imagine if families took advantage of that reality and came to church together before going to breakfast or doing something else as a family on Sunday mornings. I believe the Lord is inviting us to look at our lives a little differently, and to make the practice of our faith the priority it should be. I pray that there will be a renewal in the practice of the faith here at St. Luke.

In September we will celebrate four Confirmation Masses in our parish. The bishop has given pastors a special permission, called an indult, to impart the Sacrament of Confirmation on the young people who should have received the sacrament last spring. In the same way, I will encourage parents, sponsors, and those to be confirmed to see the sacrament not as an "end," but as a new beginning in their lives as Catholics. When we receive the Sacrament of Confirmation we are fully initiated in the faith. The gifts of the Holy Spirit assist us throughout our lives to do and say what God expects of us as His disciples. Let us pray for the young people of St. Luke Parish who will be confirmed in September, that the Lord will renew them in their faith and commitment as His followers.

I thank everyone for your prayers and concern during my recent bout with the shingles. It seems that it was a mild case, and I am grateful to Fr. Paul and Fr. Nick for covering things in the parish while I was keeping my distance and getting some rest. Happy Labor Day!



St. Luke is now open for Mass!

- The regular Mass has resumed as of June 29th.
- Those who are ill or showing signs of illness should NOT come to church.
- Congregation is limited to 25% capacity.
- Masks must be worn.
- Social distancing of 6 feet must be maintained for individuals.
- Pews will be clearly marked to show where people may or may not sit.
- There will be no hymnals used during liturgies.
- There will be no holy water in the fountains.
- There will be no servers, only 1 lector, and Extraordinary Ministers will be assigned as needed.
- There will be no procession at the beginning or end of Mass.
- There will be no holding hands during the Lord's Prayer and no exchange of peace.
- Those receiving Holy Communion are urged to receive in the hand.

PLEASE NOTE:

The obligation to attend Mass is still dispensed in the Diocese of Brooklyn.
