The Twenty Third Sunday of Ordinary Time Saint Luke Church, Whitestone, New York

Dear Friends,

Here we are at the first weekend of September and Labor Day. Officially, we have made it through two-thirds of 2020, arguably the longest year of our lives! Here at St. Luke we have resumed the regular Mass schedule for Sundays and weekdays. St. Luke School will reopen this week for the first time since March. The school has been re-configured to accommodate the required social distancing, adequate hand-sanitizing stations, and all other guidelines specified by the state, city and diocese. Mrs. Brunswick and several of the staff and teachers worked together all summer long to plan for the re-opening of the school, and I am truly grateful for their sacrifices and hard work. We pray for a safe and healthy return of our faculty, staff and students this week.

With regard to the Religious Education Program, the diocese has mandated a fully remote program at least through December 2020. I am grateful to Sr. Katherine, Lisa Scardamaglia, and all the volunteer catechists who are doing all they can to provide a new year of faith formation to the children of our community, especially those who will be preparing for sacraments this year. Fr. Paul Kim, Fr. Nicholas Colalella and I will do all that we can to support the ministry to the children in our school and religious education program.

The staff will soon be meeting to determine how we will minister to the community outside of the liturgies and sacramental celebrations that take place in church. The diocese regularly revises guidelines for parishes, and so we need to review the latest directives to see how we can accommodate the various ministries that usually take place at St. Luke. I ask you to please be patient as we try to plan for this coming fall.

This coming Friday our nation will commemorate the 19th anniversary of the 9/11 attacks on our nation. It is our custom here at St. Luke to celebrate an evening Mass to remember all the victims of the attacks, particularly our parishioners who lost their lives on that day. Mass will be celebrated at 7:30 PM and everyone is invited to attend.

The fiscal year of the parish ended on August 31st. As you can imagine, the financial situation of the parish has been struggling over the past several months. I am grateful to all those who are in a position to continue to support the parish generously at this time. When it comes to stewardship, the Church speaks of sacrificial giving. Perhaps these past few months have made that concept clearer than ever before. The diocese also relies on our support through the Annual Catholic Appeal. Parishioners will soon receive a letter from me asking for your assistance to help our parish reach our goal for 2020. As the new pastor here, it is not easy to make these requests, but the viability of our parish depends on the generosity of our parishioners. Please remember that electronic giving is available; information is available on the parish website.

St. Luke is now open for Mass!

- The regular Mass has resumed as of June 29th.
- Those who are ill or showing signs of illness should NOT come to church.
- Congregation is limited to 25% capacity.
- · Masks must be worn.
- Social distancing of 6 feet must be maintained for individuals.
- Pews will be clearly marked to show where people may or may not sit.

- There will be no hymnals used during liturgies.
- There will be no holy water in the fonts.
- There will be no servers, only 1 lector, and Extraordinary Ministers will be assigned as needed.
- There will be no procession at the beginning or end of Mass.
- There will be no holding hands during the Lord's Prayer and no exchange of peace.
- Those receiving Holy Communion are urged to receive in the hand.

The obligation to attend Mass is still dispensed in the Diocese of Brooklyn.






