

## The Twenty Fifth Sunday of Ordinary Time Saint Luke Church, Whitestone, New York

#### Dear Friends,

You may have noticed that I have been listed on the bulletin as "Administrator" since I arrived at the end of June. Although I have certainly been appointed the new pastor of St. Luke, it is the custom to serve as administrator until officially installed as pastor. Bishop DiMarzio was already scheduled to officiate at Mass on October 18<sup>th</sup> to bring our 150<sup>th</sup> Anniversary celebrations to a close. Unfortunately, many of the planned events were postponed or cancelled because of COVID-19. Since he is already coming on that day, we thought that the feast day of our parish patron was a very appropriate day for my installation as pastor of St. Luke. The staff and I will work on the details for the celebration and we will provide further information very soon. In the meantime I ask for your prayers that the Lord will give me the gifts and abilities that I will need to serve this community, together with the parish staff, to provide for the spiritual needs of the people entrusted to our care for many years to come.

On Wednesday this week, the Church celebrates the feast of St. Pio of Pietrelcina. Padre Pio was a Capuchin priest who served in San Giovanni Rotondo, a small town in the province of Foggia in Southern Italy. He had the stigmata – the wounds of the crucified Christ – from very early in his priesthood until his death in 1968. He spent countless hours in the confessional and was known to be able to read hearts and souls, especially when a penitent was withholding a sin from confession. Devotion to Padre Pio is worldwide, and he was canonized by Pope St. John Paul II in 2002 with one of the largest crowds that ever gathered for a canonization at the Vatican. There are many Padre Pio prayer groups all over the world, including here at St. Luke, that look to him for his intercession and inspiration. We will hold a Triduum in his honor on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday this week at 7:00 PM. There will be a Holy Hour on Monday and Tuesday, and a Mass on Wednesday. These will be bi-lingual celebrations, and everyone is welcome to join in these devotions to St. Padre Pio.

As we celebrate the Confirmations of the young people of St. Luke parish this month, I am certainly open to encouraging the newly confirmed to actively participate in the life of the parish by becoming lectors. In my previous parish assignments I have found that high school students are often very good at public speaking and are happy to get involved in this way. I also know that students in Catholic high schools are often trained to become Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion as juniors and seniors, and I am happy to have them help with the distribution of the Eucharist here at St. Luke. Those who have been altar servers in grammar school and in junior high are welcome to continue in that ministry in high school. Confirmation should set us on fire with the Holy Spirit to serve the Lord by serving our brothers and sisters. If anyone is interested in taking on these ministries here at St. Luke, please contact me at the rectory.

The US Bishops have asked us to take up a collection for an Emergency Disaster Fund to help with the aftermath of Hurricane Laura and the wildfires that are devastating the west coast of our nation. We will take a voluntary collection on September 26/27, and we are grateful for your generosity. I am also truly grateful for your efforts to help us meet our goal in the Annual Catholic Appeal. May God reward you for your goodness.

- Those receiving Holy Communion are urged to receive in the hand.




Classes will start in the beginning of October, information regarding the classes will be sent by email as soon as dates are finalized.






