The Twenty Sixth Sunday of Ordinary Time Saint Luke Church, Whitestone, New York

Dear Friends,

Fall is here! The days and evenings are getting a little cooler, and hopefully we will more and more return to our regular routines. I am grateful to all the ministers who help us every week to celebrate Mass and those who sanitize the church after every liturgy for the benefit of the whole parish family. We are truly blessed by the generosity and service of so many people!

The feast of St. Francis of Assisi falls on a Sunday this year, so we will hold the annual blessing of the animals on Saturday, October 3rd at 12:00 PM in the church parking lot. All are welcome.

As I mentioned last week, Bishop DiMarzio will come on Sunday, October 18th to celebrate the Feast of St. Luke and to install me as pastor of the parish. FOR THAT SUNDAY ONLY, we will celebrate Mass at noon, merging the 11:45 and 1:00 PM Masses. Due to COVID restrictions, there will be no reception following the Mass, but I will be grateful for your prayerful participation to ask the Lord to bless me as I begin my pastoral ministry here at St. Luke.

With regard to scheduling activities in the parish, for the time being we must follow the following guidelines:

25% of total occupancy (for the Parish Center, the maximum is 60 people)

Hand sanitizer is available

Masks/face covering must be worn at all times

People must sit at least six feet apart

No food can be served to prevent the sharing of utensils and gathering in close proximity Space must be sanitized after every use

I ask groups that wish to use the Parish Center to strictly observe these guidelines. Some groups might consider meeting less frequently for the time being. Since our maintenance staff is limited, I ask groups using the Parish Center or any parish facilities to sanitize the space used before they leave. Please contact me regarding the scheduling of parish activities.

When October arrives this week, we begin the month with two wonderful celebrations: on October 1st we celebrate St. Therese of Lisieux, the Little Flower. Many Catholics consider her one of their favorite intercessors, and we are always grateful when she sends us flowers from heaven. On October 2nd we celebrate the Guardian Angels. From a young age, many of us were taught to pray to our guardian angels "to light and guard, to rule and guide." The saints and angels are always ready to help us grow in holiness and draw nearer to God's love. May we always find them to be faithful intercessors for our families and for our parish community.


