Dear Friends,

I thank you for your patience last weekend as I made the in-pew appeal for the Annual Catholic Appeal (ACA) and gave a brief presentation on the parish finances. I prefer to preach the gospel, but at times it is necessary to address the temporal issues of the parish. About ten envelopes were returned in the baskets last weekend: an additional \$1,383.00 was promised for the ACA, with most of it given immediately either by cash or check. I'm sure other parishioners will return envelopes this weekend or make donations directly through the mail or online. We receive weekly reports on Mondays, so we will keep you up-to-date every week. Thank you for your generosity.

Next weekend Bishop DiMarzio will come to the parish to celebrate our parish feast and to officially install me as the 11th pastor of St. Luke. Please remember that the Mass will be at 12:00 Noon, and there will be no 11:45 AM or 1:00 PM Mass on that day. Unfortunately, because of the COVID-19 restrictions, we cannot have a parish reception after the Mass. I am limiting guests to my immediate family so as to allow as many parishioners as possible to attend the feast and installation. Please keep me in your prayers as I begin my pastoral ministry here at St. Luke.

The Mass with Bishop DiMarzio was supposed to be the closing event of the 150th Anniversary celebrations. Since several key events had to be postponed because of the pandemic, we hope to reschedule some of them as soon as possible when it is safe to do so. I am grateful to Lisa Scardamaglia and all the members of the 150th Anniversary Committee for their hard work and planning over the past year, and I pray that we can reschedule some of the festivities in 2021.

As you know, the Mass book for 2021 will soon open. Last year, Bishop DiMarzio asked parishes to consider eliminating a Mass based on attendance, but our parish did not make any change at that time. The parish staff gave me input regarding their observations of attendance at the various Masses, and their opinions were mixed. Taking their advice into consideration, I have decided that as of January 2021, we will merge the 11:45 AM and 1:00 PM Masses and celebrate Mass at 12:00 Noon. With regard to the Mass book, we will now take intentions for Masses on Sundays and Holydays of Obligation. I am obliged to make sure that a "Mass for the People of the Parish" is celebrated on those days, so that Mass will rotate through the Masses from week to week. We will also continue to celebrate a weekly Mass for those enrolled in the Purgatorial Society. Since the Italian Mass is only offered once a week, we will allow up to five intentions to be included at the Sunday 9:00 AM Mass. On Federal Holidays, we will offer one Mass at 9:30 AM instead of at 8:30 AM. The offering for announced Masses is \$15.00. Beginning this Christmas, we will provide Mass Remembrance envelopes for Christmas and Easter in addition to Mother's Day, Father's Day and All Souls Day. More information regarding the Mass book is contained in this bulletin.

I have been working on putting together a new parish website. Several years ago I learned how to create and manage a website because I felt that it is difficult to keep a website up-to-date when you rely on a third party to create and update it. I hope to have it uploaded by next weekend, and it will be a work in progress for a little while, especially since so many things are on hiatus because of COVID-19. I also hope to establish email addresses for parish staff members and other parish leaders and groups with our parish domain name (@stlukewhitestone.org) to make it easier for parishioners to communicate with us. I hope to provide more information soon.

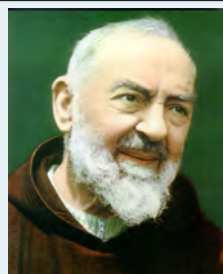

PreK Loves Apples!



Ms. Kelley's PreK class loves apples, but we don't like to eat brown apples. Why does an apple turn brown after it is cut and how can we prevent it? Each table got an apple slice on a paper plate. We did not eat it, we just watched it. Then we got a 2nd apple slice in a cup and fresh lemon juice was squeezed on it. We watched both apples for several minutes and made our predictions. The apple with lemon juice.

The apple without the lemon juice turned brown because of the oxidation process. But the apple with fresh lemon juice did not turn brown, as lemon juice contains citric acid which helps to prevent the oxidation.
